This Sunday we celebrate Father's Day. It is a wonderful occasion for all of us to pause and give thanks for our "Fathers" and the blessing they have been to us. St. Joseph, the foster father of Jesus, and patron of all fathers, gives us an example of what a father is and should be. On Sunday, June 30th, Cardinal Cupich will celebrate a Mass and procession at Holy Name Cathedral beginning at noon. Most importantly, take time to renew your relationship once again with the Lord.

Your Deacon Daydreams

Happy Father's day to all my fellow fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, stepfathers & those who have been like fathers to us. To be a great father, you first must be a great husband. Our 44th wedding anniversary was on the 14th, Flag day. June traditionally was the month for weddings. Our wedding bands invited us to become a family in the best way possible. I cried when I learned that we were expecting each son. Being a father is a great responsibility. What we do as a father will impact generations to come. Our children learn by watching us even more than what we say. Hopefully they will become the type of parents that we were. Children learn by example, but as I said, when you are married in the faith, Jesus enters into the union as well, giving us the strength, love & graces so that we can share them with our wife, children & grandchildren. Who doesn't need that when divorce rates are high & people living together rather than marrying even higher. As Catholics to be in full communion with the church, we must be married in the church in order to receive sacraments. So, if anyone needs their marriage blessed, please talk to me or the priests. We want you to enjoy the graces God offers freely. It's the greatest gift, next to loving their mother, you can give to your kids as well. Remember, Jesus' 1st miracle happened at the Wedding Feast of Cana when the water was turned into wine. It's so vital!

I saw on Facebook a picture of what Dads vs Moms are treated to on their special days. Moms are given a lavish feast at a restaurant & dads appreciate a good barbecue more. Don't panic, I know it's unofficially summertime & the news is reporting that those condiments we enjoy like relish, mustard, ketchup are costing 30% more than last year. Inflation at its worst. But the good news comes from today's gospel of the parable of the mustard seed. From the tiniest of seeds, the largest tree in the garden will grow. Jesus compares it to the kingdom of heaven. Families are the 1st church too, father, mother & children.

Children are great for asking questions especially "Why?" As teens, they begin to ask more probing questions, questions that look for some kind of light to be cast on the deeper issues of life. In time, they may come to realize that clear answers are not always to be found to life's more profound questions. As adults we often have to reconcile ourselves to living with many unanswered questions. We discover that all our searching will never exhaust the many mysteries of life. We continue to realize that coming to terms with 'not knowing' is an important part of life's journey.

Today, Jesus begins with the statement, 'This is what the kingdom of God is like.' He seems to be saying that if the farmer does not know the ways of the humble seed, how can anyone fully know the ways of God? If growth in the natural world is mysterious, how much more mysterious must be the growth of God's kingdom? Jesus says His kingdom can be growing among us in ways that we do not fully understand, just as the seed the farmer sows in the ground grows to harvest in ways he does not understand. There is a hopeful message here for all of us who may be discouraged by the slow progress that the ways of God appear to be making in the world. The spreading of God's reign is ultimately God's work & that work is always under way. There are little seeds of the kingdom that all of us can sow, a friendly gesture towards someone in trouble, a welcoming smile for someone who is alone, a sign of closeness for someone who is in despair, a little ray of joy for a heart full of distress. God's reign comes in power through the seemingly insignificant actions of each of one us. See you in church?

Sacramental & Ongoing Formation

Faith Formation is open for students in 1st through 8th grade (ages 6-14 yrs) which includes sacramental preparation of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Note that sacramental preparation is a 2-year process and participants must attend Faith Formation for two years before receiving a sacrament.

Order of Christian Initiation of Children (OCIC)

OCIC is open for youth in grades 6th - 12th grade, unbaptized or baptized. These classes are designed to prepare them to be fully received into the Catholic Church through the reception of sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation at the Easter Vigil.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)

OCIA is open for adults, 18 years & older, unbaptized or baptized. These classes are designed to prepare the youth to be fully received into the Catholic Church through the reception of sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation at the Easter Vigil.

Formación en la Fe

La Formación en la Fe está abierta para estudiantes de 1^o a 8^o grado (edades 6 a 14 años), que incluye la preparación sacramental de la Primera Comunión y la Confirmación. Tome en cuenta que la preparación sacramental es un proceso de 2 años y los participantes deben asistir a la Formación en la Fe a lo largo de dos años antes de recibir un sacramento.

Estas clases están diseñadas para preparar a los adultos a ser recibidos plenamente en la Iglesia Católica a través de la recepción de los sacramentos del Bautismo, la Primera Comunión y la Confirmación en la Vigilia Pascual.

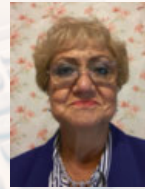
